## “Historical Books 1” Course Outline

I would like to welcome you to Titus Baptist Seminary. The course you are about to take is called “Historical Books 1.” It is designed to teach the student a survey of the books, Joshua, Judges, Ruth, I Samuel, II Samuel, and part of I Kings.

The course will take eight (8) to complete with your test scheduled for the ninth (9<sup>th</sup>) week. It can be very intense when considering the amount of reading and study time involved. Please keep up and do not get behind. The textbook for the course is “Willmington’s Guide to the Bible” by Dr. H.L. Willmington. You may purchase the textbook online, at sites such as Amazon.com, your local Christian bookstore, or from TBS. The book will be necessary at the beginning of the course for reading and study.

Below are the expectations of the course.

- I. All DVDs have to be viewed as assigned. Please refer to assignment spreadsheet. It will tell your weekly DVD viewing assignment
- II. Read the chapters from your textbook as assigned each week.
- III. Read all Bible references given in the textbook as you read the textbook assignments.
- IV. You will write two papers during the course. Each paper must be at least two pages in length. The paper should be in your words concerning one of the topics studied thus far. Remember that this is college work and must reflect that level of quality. Please put serious thought in your papers. They do not have to be typed but must legible. The papers are due at the end of the course but are expected to be completed according to your assignment sheet. Once you have taken the course, “Homiletics”, all papers will be completed in TBS outline format. If you’ve not taken that course as of yet, don’t worry about it.
- V. You will have an open book test at the end of the course. The test will have a two hour time limit. If you keep good notes from each class, you will not have a problem making a good grade.

Remember that all work must be done with a King James Bible. Any work listed from another version will receive a failing grade.
