Dear Pastors and Friends,

Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. We serve a God who "...calleth those things which be not as though they were" (Rom 4:17b). He took an old sinner like me and called me a saint. No matter what others see, God sees a saint. God wants his children to be like Him. With faith in Him, we too can see something that is not as though it were. Abraham learned and exercised this as mentioned in the following verses, Rom 4:18-21.

1. Confident in his Hope in God (v. 18)
2. Considered not his Circumstances (v. 19)
3. Continued Forward in his Faith (v. 20)
4. Convinced that God Could and Would Do It for Him (v. 21)

In the last two months, we have visited students in each of the 7 prisons where our seminary has been placed as a program. This puts us on the road a lot. Over one 4 day period, we visited 4 prisons in 3 states and traveled a total of 1710 miles. To God be the Glory!!!

Our newest prison, Wheeler Correctional Facility, is in Alamo, Georgia. The Chaplain there has assigned a 62 man dormitory to Titus Baptist Seminary. The men have to make application with TBS and be approved by the Chaplain to be in that dorm. We had the opportunity to preach there a couple of weeks ago to 62 men, all students of Titus Baptist Seminary. We have also had inquiries about our seminary from facilities in Lexington, KY and Lexington, MS. Bro Howard Collier, Supervisor Chaplain at a federal facility in Cumberland, Maryland has asked us to submit our request through the warden there about another new startup at that facility. I stand Amazed!!! What will He do next?

Our foreign mission part of the ministry continues to be very busy. Pastor Dipak Nayak from India who visited with us in August has returned to his homeland and started a satellite college there with 22 students teaching them 3 days a week. He is able to service preachers of his native country of India and on the borders of Nepal, China, and Bangladesh. Pastor Dipak has also agreed to begin to video our courses in his native language so that they can be shipped to other areas with the same language. What a great blessing this will be. If you know of a preacher or pastor who would be willing to help us with another language, please tell them to call us at our main number, 706-416-2121.

One of our missionaries in the Philippines, Pastor Dan Woody Mangligot, will be making a visit to our office in the month of November and early December. We would love to have him visit any church that might consider him for support. He is the pastor of one church and has started two other missions in his area, one of them being a prison. I personally have visited his work in the Philippines and can tell you that he is worthy of your prayers and support.

God continues to supply our needs through partners like you. There are not words enough to express our gratitude. We consider it an honor to serve with you in His great cause.
