Dear Pastors and Friends,

Greetings in Name that is above every name, the Lord Jesus Christ. I was studying for a lesson this past week and came across one of my favorite passages of Scripture.

Psalm 27:13 I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

I know that there is coming a day when we shall live in the presence of the Lord forever, but I am ever thankful that I can see His goodness while I reside on this earth. May I say to you, He has been good to me and my family!!! Best decision I ever made was trusting in my Saviour as Master of my life. It has been a good trip.

This past two months, once again, have been very busy. Since our last prayer letter, I have conducted 4 different graduations. Three of those were at prison facilities.

Forrest City Correctional Complex—Low	- 13 two-year graduates (Associate of Theology)
Maxwell Prison Camp	- 5 two-year graduates (Associate of Theology)
Stone County Correctional Facility	- 8 two-year graduates (Associate of Theology)

The other graduation was held at my home church, Faith Baptist Church in LaGrange, GA. Ten graduates walked across the stage and received their 4-year degrees, 9 Bachelor of Theology degrees and 1 Biblical Studies degree. When we began this journey 4 years ago, this day was in our mind. It was a very busy 4 years but worth it. God has been with us every step of the way mapping out our path, opening doors, and leading the way. And this is only the beginning. God has been good to us!!! There is no doubt in our mind that He will continue to be good to this ministry.

Many opportunities to preach were given to me as well the past two months. I was privileged to preach a Missions Conference at Heritage Baptist Church in Roanoke, AL. God moved in the conference and topped it off my saving 1 precious soul.

As I write this letter, I am preparing to board a plane tomorrow and head back to Papua New Guinea. Bro. Holmes Tako, the Pastor of Morata Baptist Church in Port Moresby will pick me up on Friday and we will begin a 3 week tour of the country. So far, we are scheduled to preach just about every day. A mission that God gave me last year will be accomplished as well. A Bible Seminary will be planted in the city of Alotau where 20 men and women have surrendered to plant churches on 200 islands just off their coast. I have been excited about this mission all year long. Please pray that it will go as planned and that many souls will be saved and disciplined.

Our pastor friends, Bro Eric Pedro and Bro. Dan Woody Mangligot have asked me to make another trip to the Philippines. We are praying about this trip for next year. We planted two Bible Seminaries there 3 years ago. Both seminaries need a little help and guidance. I would appreciate your prayers here as well.

Once we return from Papua New Guinea, our focus will be back on reaching more prisons and beginning the new school year at Titus Baptist Seminary.

Thank you for your prayers and support. God uses you to move this ministry forward. I personally can't pay you back for your goodness to us, but I serve a God who can and will. Call on me if I can ever be of service to you.
