Sorry it has taken so long to get this letter to you. It has been very busy the past three months. I left the last week of June for Papua New Guinea to meet with Pastor Holmes Tako and work from his church, Morata Baptist Church in our mission there. Our three weeks there was well spent. God gave us the opportunity to preach in 4 different churches and a camp meeting. **Seventeen (17) glorious souls were saved during those meetings along with five (5) men being called to preach the Gospel and four (4) women surrendering to full time service to the Lord.** I met many new pastors and preachers during our time in these meetings. God has some very choice men and women serving Him in Papua New Guinea.

While in Alotau, Papua New Guinea, God allowed us to complete our mission and set up our 2nd satellite seminary. Seventeen (17) men and women came to the first orientation with the promise of many more to come. Their main mission is to train at Titus Baptist Seminary and then witness and plant churches on the islands just off the coast of Papua New Guinea. Please pray for this endeavor. It is on my heart and the hearts of many others in the Alotau region. We also learned in August that the 1st satellite seminary in Port Moresby increased from six (6) students to forty-three (43) students. This brings us to a total of sixty (60) students attending Titus Baptist Seminary there in Papua New Guinea. Praise His Name!!!

God gave us the opportunity to go into our seventeenth (17) prison in August. Bro. Jonas Horn invited us to join him in a meeting at the Carroll Montgomery Regional Correctional Facility in Vaiden, MS. It was a joy to see and preach with Bro. Gabe Beck and Bro. Tim Parker. I had not seen them in a while. **The Lord also gave me the opportunity that same month to lead a young man to the Him** while working with my church on a ministry to our city. Praise the Lord for His work!!!

The number 17 keeps coming up in this letter. This is the number of spiritual victory. Praise God for his victories!!!

August is also the month when each of our satellite campuses to include our main campus in LaGrange, Georgia begin their new school year. There is a lot of work that takes place to get each ready to begin their studies. Each one has begun on time and with great excitement.

I have a personal prayer request that I would appreciate each of you adding to your daily prayer list. It has always been my opinion that any person who leads a ministry should train someone else to lead the ministry in the case that God calls him home. As of now I do not have that person to train. Would you please pray that God would send that man my way and give that man the courage to surrender to this great ministry. Thank you in advance for your prayers.

As always, there is no way to do what we do at Titus Baptist Seminary and our Mission Projects without your constant prayers and support. Thank you from the bottom of my heart.
